

National Music Centre Announces Call for Applications for 2024 OHSOTO'KINO Recording Bursary for Indigenous Artists

Call for applications open now for recording bursary, closes on January 7, 2024

A new national call for applications for the National Music Centre's 2024 OHSOTO'KINO Recording Bursary has been announced. The OHSOTO'KINO Recording Bursary is open to Indigenous musicians in Canada, and submissions across all genres are welcome.

Two bursaries will be offered: one to a traditional artist or group, and another to a contemporary artist or group. Selected by NMC's National Indigenous Programming Advisory Committee, artists will be awarded a one-week recording session in Calgary, Alberta to produce a commercial release. They will also have access to NMC's "living collection" of musical instruments and world-class recording studios. Travel stipends are available for this program.

Past artists that have participated in the program include traditional powwow and round dance artist Joel Wood (of Maskwacis, Alberta in Treaty 6 Territory), who received a 2023 JUNO Awardnomination for his album, *Mikwanak Kamôsakinat*, which was a result of his studio time. Traditional group Blackfoot Singers (from Sweetgrass First Nation in Saskatchewan), and Ottawa indie-folk/pop duo Twin Flames have

recorded albums, too.


